# Pastor's Page: Faithful in February

"To offer hope to our community and world through the Good News, and to make disciples of Jesus Christ"

based on Matthew 28:19 One of my favorite Bible verses is Colossians 2:7, "rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness." (NIV)

What better way to live our lives than to be faithful to God? I read several blogs every day. One that I particularly like is called: **Prayer + Possibilities** by Kathryn Shirey. Her latest post talked about a need for deep down soul cleansing. She included a "prayer template," she labeled the P.A.S.T. system. She wrote, "With Lent approaching - a time of penitence and reflection about our faith - I got to thinking how often we put off taking a 'spiritual bath'. How often do you come before God in your prayers to ask for spiritual cleansing? We accumulate the 'dirt' of the world every day. In the words of the Prayer of Confession in the Book of Common Prayer, we continually sin in 'thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone.' Maybe you pray a prayer like this on Sunday mornings, but does your heart need a deeper

scrubbing? Do you need to take some time to really lay it all before God and ask for his cleansing? Over these next several weeks, as we approach Lent, I'll be sharing some ways you can lean into this season to reflect on your faith and open your heart for God to do more of His work in your life. I pray you'll find some ways to make this a Holy Lenten season - a season of spiritual renewal and rebirth. This week, I'm sharing a template for praying a cleansing prayer for your soul. The P.A.S.T. prayer will help you ask God for purification and cleansing from all the 'dirt' in your life, laying all your shortcomings at the foot of the cross."

Shirey goes on to explain the meaning of P.A.S.T.:

Praise, Acknowledge,
Supplication, Thanksgiving.
We need to praise God in every circumstance of our lives. We need to acknowledge our sinfulness and ask God to forgive us. We need to get down on our knees (physically if possible – spiritually always) and humbly ask God to renew and restore us – that's supplication. Of course, we need to end our cleansing

prayer with thanksgiving for all that God has done and continues to do – in spite of us and through us. When we do all these things, God is faithful – God loves us with an everlasting love – and we will be cleansed from the inside out. Think of this as a bubble bath for your soul (OK, for you gentlemen, an invigorating shower).

In February, as we approach Lent, I want you to know that I am praying for each and everyone of you. In February, we think of love – and hearts abound – in decorations, cards, and our minds. Think of God's love and His faithfulness, which endures forever. Every time you see a heart, please pray for the cleansing of your soul as well as pray for others around you. That's how we practice our faith – and how we renew our minds because we are rooted and grounded in Christ Jesus, our Lord and Savior.


